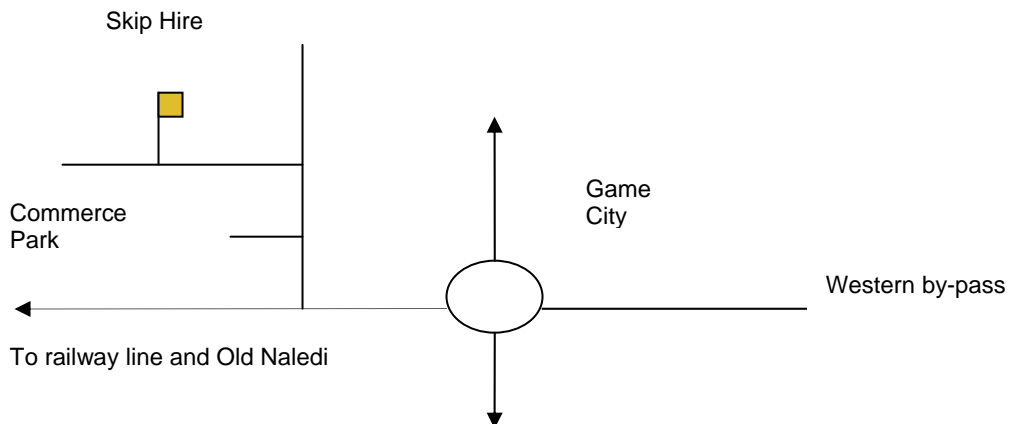
Profile – Harold Hester

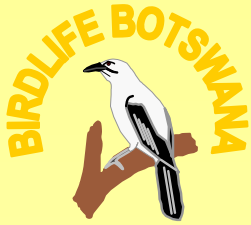
